The bronze maker wants to cast bronze axes. Unfortunately, his forms got mixed up. Based on the mirror image, find casting molds that match those in the frame.



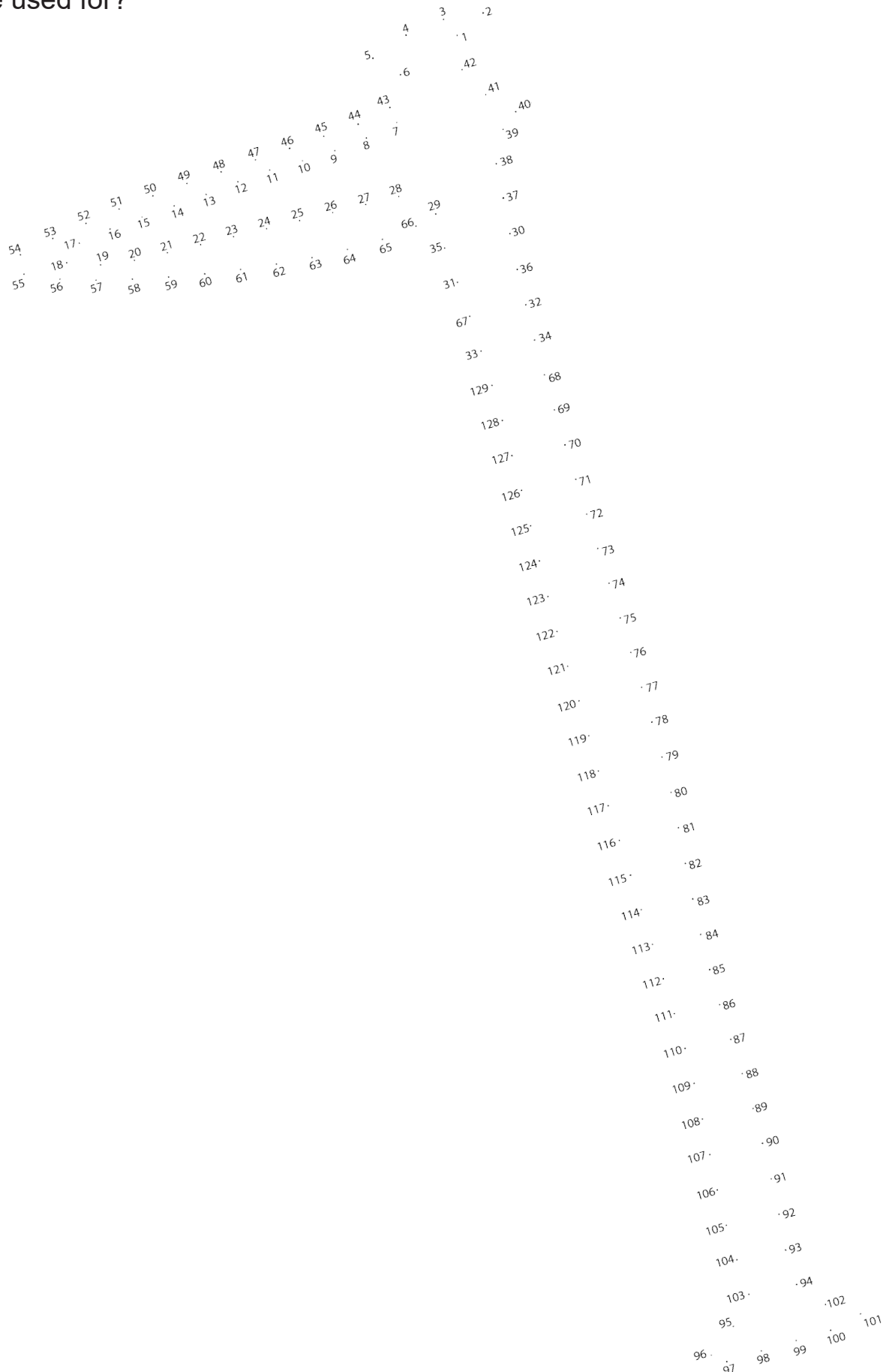
Task 2
