1st Circular

The present letter is an invitation to the eleventh successive conference, following the "Dymaczewo Conference" in 1980, as always devoted to the prehistory of Northeastern Africa.

The Symposium is organized by the Poznań Archaeological Museum and the Institute of Archaeology and Ethnology of the Polish Academy of Sciences. Archaeologists and specialists from other fields of research (geomorphology and geology, human ecology, climatology, archaeobotany, archaeozoology, physical anthropology, rock art etc.) working in Northeastern Africa and neighboring regions, as long as their work is topically connected, are invited to attend.

The Symposium will be held on the premises of the Poznań Archaeological Museum. The Museum is located at the corner of the mediaeval Old Market Square, in a beautiful and attractive setting, and there are numerous hotels, hostels and pensions situated in the vicinity of the Museum.

The deadline for submitting titles of papers/posters and abstracts (maximum 1 standard page) is **30 November 2018**. The duration of the presentation should not exceed 15 min for one paper. Poster session is also planned.

The regular conference fee is **120 Euro** and **90 Euro for students and retired scholars** if paid till the end of March 2018. For later the payment is **140 Euro** and **90 Euro for students**.

Details as to the fee transfer will be forwarded in the Second Circular **in December 2018**, which will come in due course to those who return the Registration Form.
