### International Symposium From foragers to farmers in Northeastern Africa (Poznań, 3-6 July 2023)

#### 1st Circular

This letter is an invitation to the twelfth conference on the prehistory of Northeastern Africa organised periodically following the first “Dymaczewo Conference” in 1980.

The Symposium is hosted by the Poznań Archaeological Museum and the Institute of Archaeology and Ethnology of the Polish Academy of Sciences. Archaeologists and specialists in other fields (geomorphology and geology, human ecology, climatology, archaeobotany, archaeozoology, physical anthropology, rock art etc.) conducting their research in Northeastern Africa and neighbouring regions, as long as their work is thematically connected, are invited to participate.

The Symposium will be held in the Poznań Archaeological Museum, in the picturesque setting of the Old Market Square. The Museum is located conveniently within easy reach of hotels, hostels and guest houses.

The deadline for submitting titles of papers/posters and abstracts (maximum one standard page) is **31 December 2022**. The duration of presentations should not exceed 15 min per paper. A poster session is also planned.

The conference fee paid before 1 April 2023 is €160 for academics and €90 for B.A., M.A. and PhD students and retired scholars. After that date, the fee is €200 for academics and €140 for B.A., M.A. and PhD students and retired scholars.

The payment details will be sent together with the Second Circular **in January 2023** to those who submit the registration form.
